#### BAA AWARDS

The Business Achievement Awards (BAAs) is a co-curricular program which provides opportunities for members to develop their leadership skills, expand their business knowledge, and contribute to their local communities. There are four levels to this program: Future, Business, Leader, and America, with each level's tasks becoming increasingly more challenging, ranging from inviting a friend to an FBLA meeting to creating a resume. Completing each level allows you to earn recognition and pins at the local and state level, and finishing the America level may qualify you for Nationals Leadership Conference. #### **CSA AWARDS**

The Community Service Award (CSA) is an award earned by tracking a member's hours of community service. There are three levels to the award: Community, Service, and Achievement, requiring 50 hours, 200 hours, and 500 hours respectively. These hours are cumulative throughout a member's FBLA career and thus carry on to following years. Once the Community and Service Levels are completed, you will receive a certificate of completion, and Achievement Level will earn you a pin and recognition at the National Leadership Conference.
