Chapter Limits

Due to limited space and time, we do have to implement chapter event limits. These limits are based on the number of students you bring to the competition (**not your membership numbers**) and the CTE program you teach. Refer to the chart below for these limits. This chart shows how many individual and/or teams you can enter in those events.

Also, refer to the next page for which events are considered in your program area and are eligible to use the CTE program table (table 1 below). If the competitive events are not in your program area, you will use table 2 for chapter limits not in your CTE program area.
